The new General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) came into force on the 25th May. You may ask to see what details we hold and may cancel your consent for us to hold your data or contact you at any time. Confirmation is the Church of England way of making a public commitment to Jesus and his church. There is normally a period of preparation where you deepen your understanding of the Christian message, followed by a special Confirmation service led by the Bishop. As part of the service, you confirm your faith in God and your desire to be a disciple of Jesus, and then receive the laying on of hands to be filled with the Holy Spirit to strengthen you in your Christian journey. If you do not yet receive Holy Communion, then Confirmation is also the point at which you begin to do so.
