The event will include a liturgical gathering and then a more relaxed opportunity to engage with prayer stations and pilgrimage trails in and around the Cathedral. The prayer stations are being created by deaneries across the whole diocese. After a short closing act of worship, refreshments will be served from 4.30pm.
